ABATE encourages bikers to become politically active in their communities.

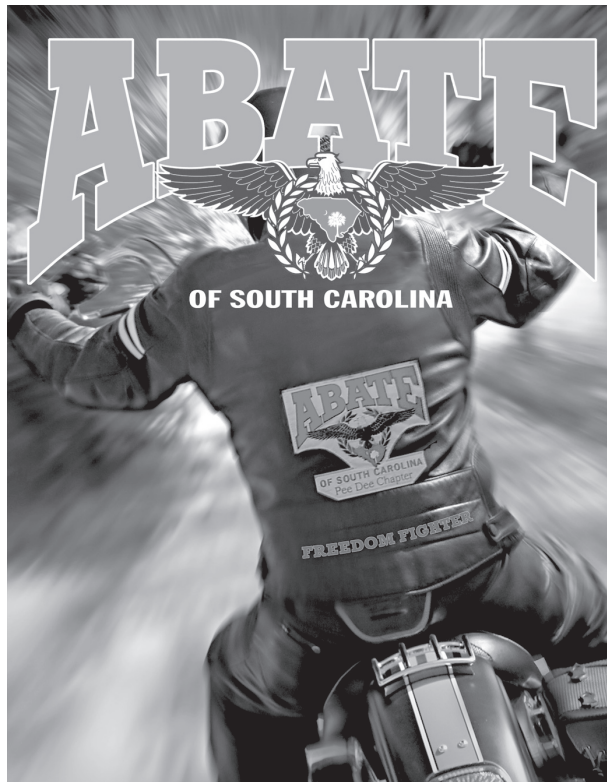
ABATE is a volunteer organization and is non-partisan and welcomes ALL RIDERS and FRIENDS of LIBERTY.

Our members brought freedom of choice to South Carolina bikers in June of 1980; ABATE amended South Carolina's mandatory motorcycle helmet law to allow adult freedom of choice. ABATE stands for A Brotherhood Against Totalitarian Enactments. Our philosophy is to defend liberty; while we do not oppose safety devices we oppose laws that mandate the usage of devices.



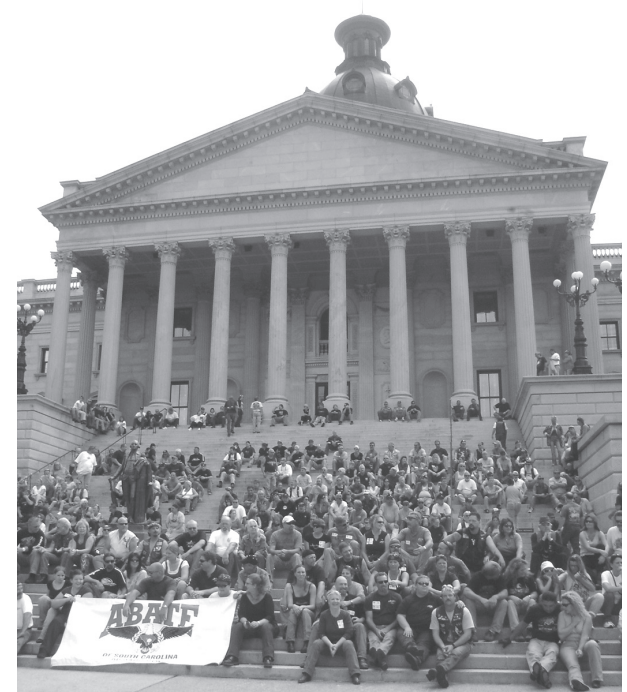

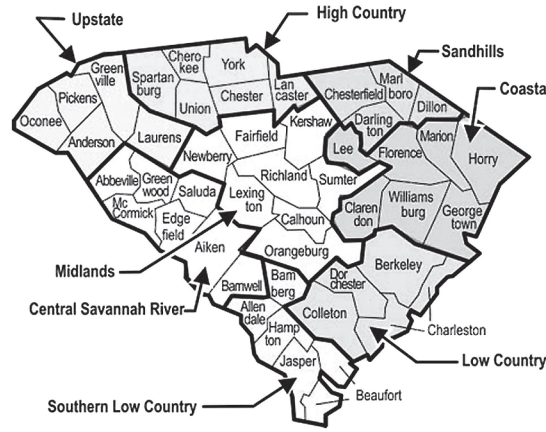
